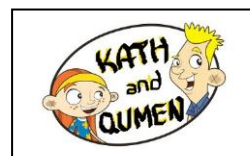

Learning about the Mass with Kath and Qumen for the First Communion pupils:

What is a Deacon? - The word Deacon comes from the Greek word "DIAKONIA", which means "service". The work of the Deacon is an act of service to the community. Deacons



can read the Gospel, preach the homily, Baptise and perform other ceremonies where there is no Mass. There are two types of Deacon who minister in the Church. The first is someone who is training to be a priest and this is the last step before finally being ordained a Priest. The second is called a Permanent Deacon and he is not going to be ordained a Priest. We know that Priests cannot get married but a married man can be ordained a

Permanent Deacon. At the moment we have very few Permanent Deacons in our country. But this may change in the next few years.
