#### Learning about the Mass with Kath and Qumen for the First Communion pupils:

<u>How Does Mass Begin</u> - Mass usually begins with a song or hymn and if we know the song we should join in the singing. The words of the song might be on a hymn sheet or book on



your seat. When this song begins we know that it is time to stand up. We stand to greet the priest who will lead us in prayer; in this way we are also greeting Jesus who is present among us.

<u>The Opening Procession</u> - Mass always begins with a procession. There are different kinds of processions. Sometimes there are lots of people; sometimes it is the priest

on his own. The procession might come from the front door or from the Sacristy. Usually the procession includes the priest and the servers. In some places the people who are going to read and help give out Communion will also be in the procession. You might see one of the readers carry the book form which the Gospel will be read. This book is called the *Book of Gospels*.
