Good News: About Child Safeguarding in Kilmore. The Second Review of Child Safeguarding Practice in the Diocese of Kilmore was completed in Aug 2018 by the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church. There were NO allegations of abuse having taken place in the years since the last review (2010). Ten allegations of historical abuse - some of them going back to the 1950s - were received since the last review. ALL of these were found to have been dealt with appropriately. The overall conclusion of the Review confirmed "that without any doubt, there is significant evidence across all the standards of quality people providing best practice approaches to child safeguarding, reporting allegations, providing flexible care to complainants and ensuring that those accused are dealt with fairly and are monitored. The work is underpinned by strong leadership and committed individuals who provide direction, training, time and concern for those children who are entrusted to their care". Sincere thanks and congratulations to all safeguarding personnel at diocesan and parish level for your hard work and commitment.
